

**Commissioners' Meeting
June 12, 2018**

Chairman Ray Garcia called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners Gerald Cisneros, Ray Garcia and Max Vezzani were present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to approve the June 5, 2018 minutes. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Bill Snelling spoke to the Board in regard to a treatment facility for opioid rehabilitation for individuals in Huerfano County.

10:06 A.M.-Frank Kirkpatrick met with the Board concerning the leaf and limb project and the use of the county wood chipper.

10:21 A.M.-Al Meisman met with the Board regarding RICO Restraint of Trade.

10:30 A.M.-Greg Riedel asked the Board for a waiver so that he may construct a pole barn on his land in Majors Ranch.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to ask the Land Use Office to survey other counties for options on how they handle such request from people who own land in the county but do not have a home in the county and postponing the decision for the next 60 days. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve Abatement #18-45 on behalf of Pamela Devore and Ross

Busby in the amount of \$481.49 for the 2017 tax year. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve a one-time pay out of compensatory time accrued to the Sheriff's Office Deputies and Detention Officers. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve Richard Martinez as the new full time Waste Transfer Operator at \$12.50 an hour effective June 16, 2018. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and Commissioner Cisneros to approve Alyis Wooten as the new Summer Intern for the Land Use and Economic Development office from June 16, 2018 to September 1, 2018 at a monthly salary of \$1733.00. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to approve purchase of a 2017 Ford pickup for the Noxious Weed Department in the amount of \$29,348.00. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to approve the closing of the County Clerk & Recorder's office on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 for Elections only. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to waive the permit fee on behalf of the Gallo Rodeo Event in Gardner. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

County Administrator John Galusha and the Board reviewed action items.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve a \$1,000.00 Sponsorship for the 4th of July Extravaganza 2018 at the Spanish Peaks Regional Health Center, keeping in mind the Stage II fire restriction and coming up with a plan in case of no moisture. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to approve re-signing of an Amended Agreement and Contract with CenturyLink in the amount of \$114,249.94 for the E911 phone system for Emergency Services. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to sign Letter of Support to PetSafe Bark for your Park Committee allocating approximately 1.3 acres located at 928 Russell in Walsenburg, Colorado. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to Release Bond #B010776 in the amount of \$50,000.00 on behalf of Dawson Geophysical Company. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve additional payment for carpet installed at the Walsenburg Mini Golf Course in the amount of \$3,634.00. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
