

COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE

MARCH 3, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ray Garcia followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners Gerald Cisneros, Ray Garcia and Max Vezzani were present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Gerald Cisneros seconded by Commissioner Ray Garcia with Commissioner Vezzani abstaining to approve the February 25, 2020 minutes. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Public Comment:

10:01A.M. Al Meisman informed the Board that he had given a dozen hazmat suits to the Sheriff's Office.

10:02 A.M. Cheryl Rogers spoke to the Board regarding the Bradford Mesa conditional use permit and asking that the Board either consider revoking their permit or require them to follow the original CUP.

10:18 A.M. Marcy Freeburg representing the homeowners on Bennett Road with their concerns of the conditions of the road and asking for help on maintenance.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve the Application for Right-of-Way Excavation Permit on behalf of Upper Huerfano County Fire Protection District and waive the permit fee. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

County Administrator John Galusha and the Board reviewed action items.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve the Letter of Support for the Museum of Friends to the Colorado State Historical Fund. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve the \$100.00 Butte Membership to the Huerfano County Historical Society. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Commissioner Vezzani and seconded by Commissioner Cisneros to approve the following conditions for the Bradford Mesa Conditional Use Permit:

- Southway Construction will provide the material required to maintain and/or improve the gravel County Road 120 from the junction with the onsite haul road for 6.9 miles from State Highway 10 to quarry entrance.
- Southway Construction will provide the material required to maintain and/or improve the onsite gravel haul road.
- Once a year or as requested, Southway Construction will finance the application of magnesium chloride to County Road 120 from junction with the onsite haul road for 6.9 miles from State Highway 10 to quarry entrance.
- Southway Construction will improve and/or replace all cattle guards along County Road 120 to a minimum of twenty (20) feet width from State Highway 10 to quarry entrance.
- Southway Construction will widen all corners along County Road 120 to a minimum width of twenty-four (24) feet for passing from State Highway 10 to quarry entrance.
- Southway Construction will have a traffic analysis conducted to include speed limit recommendations for County Road 120 prior to utilizing the road for hauling.
- To incorporated original permit.


Any expansion of the quarry outside of the boundary of the original CUP will require an application for amendment to the permit.

Staff will review the quarry operation one (1) year from the date of letter (February 18, 2020) and will advise quarry operator of any deficiencies or adverse conditions noted. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

County Administrator John Galusha and the Board reviewed correspondence.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cisneros and seconded by Commissioner Vezzani to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
