



PREPARING FOR THE CHIPPER

STEP ONE - PREPARE

Make sure your branches are stacked neatly with the “cut end” facing the road. Longer, lower stacks are preferable! Only limbs, branches and small trunks can be chipped. Rocks, dirt, metal and construction lumber cannot pass through the chipper.

STEP TWO - SAFETY STEPS*

Proper Personal Protective Equipment is Essential. You **MUST** Have:

- Leather Gloves
- Safety Goggles
- Long Pants
- Hearing Protection
- Closed Toed Shoes (preferably Boots)

*You will need to sign a volunteer liability waiver form.

STEP THREE - DISCARD

Consider what you will do with the chips. There is no capacity to haul the chips away, decide if you want them shot into a predetermined pile location, or broadcast across your property.
